# Jamaica Mission Trip 2012

## Overview

### **Purpose**

The New Beginnings Church Student Ministry desires to provide high school age students, young adults, and their families with the opportunity to share the love of Jesus Christ in a culture & environment that is distinct from their own. The purposes of this trip are: first, to share the love of Christ with the residents of Catadupa, Jamaica; second, engage in experiences that will expand our own worldview; and third, further develop the relationships previously established in Catadupa during the summer of 2010.

### **Dates & Location**

» July 1-8, 2012

» Catadupa, Jamaica - a rural mountain village in the heart of the Jamaican island

### **Cost**

### **Activities**

Participants will be involved in a variety of activities while in Jamaica including physical labor, ministry to children and families, as well as daily chores and clean up. Participants will also participate in group gatherings for worship and daily debriefings. Additionally, participants will be required to attend planning meetings in the months leading up to the trip.

### **Covenant**

Upon registration all participants will be required to sign a covenant form that will outline the agreed actions/activities of every participant. This covenant begins at registration and will continue through the duration of the trip. The covenant is threefold including spiritual, behavioral, and financial elements.

### **Registration & Participation**
